John 1:1-10

What will 2011 bring and how do we figure into God's plan for the year 2011?

What do you expect to happen in your life in 2011? This I will tell you, it is highly likely you will experience

whatever it is you expect. Because out of the abundance of your heart you will speak, what you speak, you will create! This is so very important to understand.

It is quite natural for us to look back at a year just passed and evaluate if we accomplished everything we had intended. It is just as natural to peer into the incoming year to see what it may bring. If we are unhappy with what we accomplished in the immediate year just passed, then perhaps we can learn something from this evaluation.

Take A Good Look

If we take a good look at what we have accomplished over the past 12 months or so, it is easy to see we may have been relying far to much on ourselves and our plans rather than the Lord Jesus and his plans.

If you have been a Believer for very long you will, no doubt, have heard the scripture where the Apostle Matthew these Jesus, "But seek ve first the king-

dom of God, and his righteousness: and all these things shall be added unto you. Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof." [a]

Let's Be Honest

Let's be honest, we probably know these words, penned for God, by Isaiah the prophet, "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts." [b] We, however, may not behave as if these words by either Jesus or Isaiah take precedence over how we have learned to function in this world by this world's system.

Seeking The Things

It is very interesting to note the seeking of things is what is usually done first, then if there is any energy, money, or time left over there is consideration of what God wants and, in fact, expects. Seeking God first demonstrates beyond mere intent the true Lordship of Jesus Christ in our lives. Not to seek God first, after having said we would do so, is to turn our backs on God, in favor of our own way. Consequently, year after year may well prove to be empty of our intent, as we follow each new 12 months of our own plans and devices.
